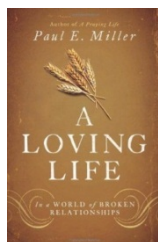


SUMMER SANCTUS — EIGHT

This will be for ages 13 to 18 (7th through 12th grades). If a student graduates from high school in May of 2015, then they should register for **SUMMER SANCTUS**. Pastor Jeff Niell will be the camp director.

GLORIA SANCTUS — ONE

This will be a new camp for ages 18 to 28 (unmarried). If you have been out of high school for a year, and at least eighteen years old, this is the camp for you. We will have a separate schedule from **SUMMER SANCTUS** and will do a number of things that will be geared to an older group. Pastor Randy Booth will be the camp director.



The **GLORIA SANCTUS** group will need to READ this book before camp starts: *A Loving Life: In a World of Broken Relationships*, by Paul Miller. The book will be sent to each camper upon registration.

COSTS: The cost per student will be \$200-Summer Sanctus, or \$215-Gloria Sanctus (early registration). We encourage students to earn all or part of their money for camp. Don't forget to add in the cost for travel and spending money at camp.
